

PhD SCHOLARSHIPS IN THE BUSHFIRE CRC

The Bushfire Cooperative Research Centre (CRC) is a \$100M, seven year national effort to deal with the social, economic, and environmental impacts of bushfires. The CRC invites applications for two full-time PhD scholarships in La Trobe's School of Psychological Science. These provide stipends of \$25,000 p.a. For holders of other awards, such as APAs, top-up scholarships of \$9,000 p.a. are also available.
