- First 3 months min. 106 hrs, c. 9 hrs/wk
- 3-9 months min. 214 hrs, c. 7-9 hrs/wk
- 9-12 months min. 122 hrs, c. 10+ hrs/wk

 12 mths + specialised skills, weekends, full days, callouts, higher level incident management training




